




An important consideration when choosing commercial hardwood flooring is the finish, (surface treatment). There are two different finishes for hardwood: Glaze Tek polyurethane, and Nu Oil®. Each finish will provide a different purpose and fashion. Larger hotels and corporate facilities would most likely use a polyurethane wood coating, like Glaze Tek


hardwood finish, where boutiques, smaller hotels could use either polyurethane or Nu Oil® finish. Nu Oil® is a hybrid durable oil finish that provides a very low sheen and reveals the natural grain of the hardwood and in most cases more than polyurethane.


